Executive Summary

The program provides 16 beds of residential treatment services for delinquent youth whose treatment needs are best served in a residential setting. Youth receive up to 20 hours of cognitive-behavioral, mentoring and therapeutic treatment per week including family therapy and educational services. These residential services are delivered through a combination of public and private funds.

This Federal and State Behavioral Rehabilitation Services (BRS) residential treatment program is funded through General Fund (25%), Local Option Levy (50%), and Federal and State BRS funding (25%). This funding provides residential treatment for male and female youth. Phoenix follows effective practices and provides an intensive level of treatment locally to youth and families without having to leave the community to access treatment, and avoid commitment to the State. General Fund pays for 1.0 FTE Supervisor, 5.0 FTE Juvenile Group Workers and 1.0 FTE Office Assistant, Sr-Bil.
