Physical health services are provided to youth in Phoenix Treatment program, and mental health transition services are provided to youth as they leave Detention. The unit also houses our division receptionist and Office Assistant.

The Program Services unit provides support to the division. This includes the mental and physical health services provided to youth being held in Detention and mental health transition services as they leave Detention. Physical health services are provided to youth in Phoenix Treatment program. The unit also houses division reception and the majority of division specific office assistant functions. The General Fund covers 1.0 FTE Supervisor, 1.0 FTE Mental Health Specialist 2, 1.0 FTE Juvenile Justice Nurse, 2.0 Bilingual Office Assistant 2, 1.0 Office Assistant 2, and 1.0 Victim Advocate.

**State/Federal Mandate**

ORS 169.740 states that juvenile facilities shall provide for counseling of any detained juvenile found to be within the jurisdiction of the court. ORS 169.076(5) states that juvenile detention facilities shall provide for emergency medical and dental health.
