**Executive Summary**

The Community Fire Recovery Coordinator will provide targeted support to community recovery efforts in rural Lane County with a focus on residents impacted by the Holiday Farm Fire. The position will work with communities to identify priorities for direct support from the County, and connect communities with other service/resource providers when support is best provided by a third party. Within the County government, the Community Fire Recovery Coordinator will serve as an advocate by helping navigate County rules, regulations, and processes. The position will also cultivate partnerships and collaborative efforts across Lane County and the broader region.

Plan and coordinate equitable support systems for wildfire victims using a trauma-informed approach. Inform Fire Recovery Operations Center of community needs to guide programs and resources. Collaborate with partners in the government, private, and non-profit sectors to identify resources and connect wildfire victims appropriately. Support the transition of wildfire victims from temporary shelter into more sustainable housing solutions. This includes 1.0 FTE, and funding for materials and supplies related to supporting this work.
