Executive Summary

Housing Strategies implements the recommendations of the TAC report (Lane County Public Shelter Feasibility Study) adopted by City of Eugene and Lane County. This service includes the Joint Shelter and Housing Strategist, which is a joint position between the City of Eugene and Lane County. Housing Coordination works with public and private partners to identify needs, sites, funding, and staffing for Emergency/Alternative Shelter and Permanent Supportive Housing. The City of Eugene is providing revenue in the amount of \$87,500. Lane County is matching that with \$87,500 in the form of a general fund transfer.
