WHEREAS, food is one of the basic necessities of life and access to safe, nutritious, affordable, adequate and culturally appropriate food is the basis for a healthy, productive community; and

WHEREAS, unacceptable numbers of Lane County residents are suffering from dietrelated diseases, are unaware of basic food nutrition, safety, preparation and production information, or are hungry or at risk of hunger; and

WHEREAS, a number of state, county and city governmental programs and operations address food, nutrition, agriculture, education and economic development matters, but there is not currently comprehensive food planning; and

WHEREAS, a partnership of local organizations, businesses and community members are dedicated to the creation of a Lane County Food Policy Council and have worked on such a concept for over a year, and

WHEREAS, a community-based food policy council which engages public and private entities and citizens in the discussion of food and agricultural issues, identification of priority policies and actions and the education of public an private sectors about food issues can provide significant improvement to Lane County's food system,

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the Lane County Board of Commissioners endorses the creation of a community-based Lane County Food Policy Council to review and recommend to the community policies, programs and food initiatives that will strengthen the local food economy, improve access to healthy and nutritious food, engage citizens in food system planning and leverage community resources.
