I. PROPOSED MOTION

MOVE APPROVAL OF THE ORDER AND RESOLUTION IN THE MATTER OF APPOINTING AMY ISLER GIBSON TO THE LANE COUNTY COMMISSION ON CHILDREN AND FAMILIES.

II. ISSUE OR PROBLEM

The Lane County Board of Commissioners has the appointing authority for membership on advisory boards and commissions pursuant to the Lane Manual and to HB 2004, and therefore approves recommendations for appointment to the Lane County Commission on Children and Families.

III. DISCUSSION

A. Background/Analysis

In 1993, the State Legislature adopted HB 2004 and directed the creation of local Commissions on Children and Families in all 36 counties throughout the state, charging the commissions with responsibility for system-wide strategic planning and implementation of a wellness model for children and families.

Pursuant to HB 2004, a majority of members, plus the chair of local commissions, must be laypersons. LCCCF must have a minimum of ten (10) laypersons and up to eight (8) professional members.

On February 16, 2005 the Membership Committee recommended to the LCCCF to appoint Amy Isler Gibson to the LCCCF. The Commission voted on and approved the committee's recommendation.

The recommended candidates are listed below, followed by the expired or resigned position they will be filling, and the expiration date of their term. Attachment A: Recommended Applicants for Appointment to the LCCCF.

I own a business called <u>Gifted Families</u>. I am primarily a family therapist specializing in relational issues for individuals, families, groups, families of individuals with disabilities, and occasionally businesses. I also do educational consulting, mediation, and grant writing. I have special interests in children and adults who have been identified as gifted, from TAG (a school id) to Asperger's Syndrome (considered part of the spectrum of autism), the coaching of children, and competition and children. I have served as the lead facilitator for the Asperger's Advocacy Coalition Parent Support Group. I am an active volunteer in the schools and with Planned Parenthood of Eugene, a Nationally Board Certified Counselor, and an intern for licensure as both a Licensed Professional Counselor and a Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist. I am in clinical supervision with Dr. John Miller, Director, Marriage and Family Therapy Program, Univ. of Oregon.

Sept. – Dec. 2001, Program Coordinator, Community Resource Bank, Center for Family Development, Eugene, Oregon. This was a project funded to gain access to classes, extracurricular activities, and goods for underprivileged "at-risk" youth.

1999-2003, Director and Coach, Fox Hollow Chess Club. I developed this after-school chess program at my sons' school. Each year we have had 40-60 students in this six month weekly after-school program; approx. 40 of those in my Beginner's Club. I have also organized large chess programs at Crest Elementary and McCornack Elementary schools in Eugene. During the summer of 2002 I helped found Chess Ways, a private school for teaching chess to children, specializing in training parents to develop clubs at their own public schools. My interest in chess lies primarily in its value as a tool for training children to manage feelings and behavior connected with competition, and secondarily in its use developing consequential reasoning. I love how you can use the game to help children slow down, focus, and

treat opponents respectfully. Also, I spent all of 2003 designing, fundraising, and producing a poster project designed to discourage bullying towards chess players by photographing top Eugene athletes (UO men's basketball, UO women's basketball, UO football, Eugene Emeralds, and, no athlete but a great advocate for kids, Eugene Mayor Jim Torrey). The posters said: Some of the Coolest People Play Chess. These posters were gorgeously produced, and donated to every school in the Eugene, Springfield, Bethel and Oakridge school districts. It was a fabulous project.

1994-1998, Family Therapist, Center for Family Development and private practice, specializing in adolescents and parenting. Also wrote and directed a grant at CFD to provide group psychotherapy for mothers of incest victims.

1987-1990: Instructor, philosophy, Oregon State University, Corvallis, Oregon. Undergraduate classes in formal and informal logic, graduate classes in ethics.

1993: Volunteer Counselor, Planned Parenthood. I counseled clients, and later, staff members as this agency began providing HIV/AIDS testing to the community.

1986-1991: Workshop Facilitator, Wings Enterprises. I was the lead facilitator for hundreds of personal and professional development workshops at this company. We specialized in helping people take accountability for their choices, recognize their potential, and take risks in ways respectful to their relationships and environment.

1991: Became stepmom to our then 4 year old James (Evergreen College), 1993 mom to Charley (Roosevelt Middle School), 1996 mom to True (Fox Hollow Elem.). I always list motherhood as the major part of my work, and of course my joy.
