II. AGENDA ITEM SUMMARY

The Human Services Commission (HSC) Community Action Advisory Committee (CAAC) seeks to fill one vacancy and reappoint eight members.

III. BACKGROUND/IMPLICATIONS OF ACTION

A. Board Action and Other History

The Community Action Advisory Committee has designated slots for recruitment within the mandated tripartite advisory board structure. (ORS 458.505)

The Lane Manual allows for twelve members of which a third are public officials currently serving or their designees, at least a third of the members represent low income persons in Lane County and the balance represent business, industry, labor, religious, welfare, education or other major groups of interest in the community. (LM 3.534)

At the close of the advertising period thirteen applications were received. The CAAC met on July 19, 2008 and recommended to forward to the Board of Commissioners for consideration, the nomination of one new candidate and the reappointment of eight members.

The remaining vacancies are currently being advertised through October 31, 2008.

B. Policy Issues

The nominees meet the minimum qualifications for service on this body. The Human Services Commission's Manager and Supervisor collaborated with the CAAC in assessing the qualifications of the candidates.

C. Board Goals

These appointments meet the Board's objective of encouraging citizen participation.

D. Financial and/or Resource Considerations

None

E. Analysis

The Community Action Advisory Committee approved the recommendation of these appointments at their June 19, 2008 meeting.

F. <u>Alternatives/Options</u>

- 1. Appoint the nominees to the CAAC.
- 2. Re-advertise and reopen the vacancies.

IV. <u>RECOMMENDATION</u>

Staff recommend adoption of option one above.

V. TIMING/IMPLEMENTATION

The nominees will become members of the CAAC upon Board approval.

VI. FOLLOW-UP

Board approval being received for this appointment, the prospective member would be issued a welcome to attend the October meeting and an orientation to the CAAC and its budgetary charge.

1. Give a brief description of the experience or training that qualifies you for membership on this advisory committee (If you wish, you may attach a resume or other pertinent material.)

I have eighteen(18 plus) years of experience and training in the field of Corrections, prison population supervision, community supervision, and programs. I have a Bachelor of Science in Political Science and an Associate Degree in Community Service. Combining my experience and training and education, I have an interest in community services needs and programs. My Community Service degree involved developing programs that service the community. My training and experience in Corrections involves supervision of convicted felons, treatment program referrals, case management, needs assessment, some budget planning, housing approval or investigation, interagency and community relations, field investigations, responsible living skills, and assess and evaluate behavior. I am currently employed with Lane County Community Corrections, as a Parole and Probation Officer. My current position allows me to provide supervisory services to individuals placed under parole and probation supervision by releasing authorities, e.g., courts, Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision, Local Supervisory Authority(jail), and the Psychiatric Security Review Board.

2. Why do you want to become a member of this committee, and what specific contributions do you hope to make?

I hope to bring knowledge and experience of the supervision of mentally ill, homeless, and developmentally delayed, the criminal justice system, prison release transition population, and the continuum of community supervision, as well as broaden my knowledge and understanding of organizational budget. I plan to contribute in planning for community service programs that service persons in need for crisis intervention and/or prevention programs. I bring a wealth of knowledge to the table on community resources available in our community. I also am aware that in the areas of community resources we fall short in serving the people of Lane County. I am a survivor of childhood family violence, and as such will contribute to supportive services for families.

Community concerns related to this committee that I would like to see addressed are the Criminal Justice System, Youth at Risk Intervention and Prevention Programs, Developmental Delayed population, the Mentally III population, Domestic Violence, as well as Elder safety.

4. Briefly describe your present or past involvement in relevant community groups. (Having no previous involvement will not disqualify you for appointment.)

I facilitated the Adult Boot Camp Community Meeting from, which was a group of felons on transitional leave or graduated from the Oregon Summit Boot Camp Program-Department of Corrections. The group consisted of supportive family members and friends attending the group with those who had graduated boot camp. The group meeting geared around cognitive change and responsible living. The basic premise of cognitive change is that thinking determines behavior. How we think, including our beliefs and attitude, determines how we behave. During the group community meeting we held offenders accountable by identifying and addressing their thinking

errors, and teaching them the skills needed to intervene and overcome these unhealthy thinking patterns. The offenders learn that they have the ability to change if they desire to do so.

I am a member of the statewide Sex Offender Supervision Network(SOSN). We members come together from around the State of Oregon to address issues around the supervision of sex offenders. Legislative matters are discussed around laws governing sex offenders, effective and safe management of sex offenders in the community, and counties policies and procedures on the supervision of sex offenders. Attending are state officials from several counties in Oregon, e.g., Parole and Probation officers, Community Corrections Supervisors, Corrections Directors, Assistant Director-Correctional Programs, Oregon Youth Authority, and State Police Sex Offender Registration Unit. The group meet quarterly.

I was a member of the Board of Directors for Passages Intensive Residential Drug and Alcohol Treatment Program. The program was a 20 bed inpatient drug and alcohol addiction program. The Board of Directors was responsible for decision making that reflected the operation of the program, budget planning, and financial spending. The program no longer exists.

I am a member of the Board of Directors for Project-Link Up, which is women in prison continuing relationships with their children. The project has curriculum class credit for UO Law School Student. The student assist in legal matters the women face while incarcerated. There has been a legal training and research for the women incarcerated at Coffee Creek Correctional Facility. Project Link-Up is helping assure the women incarcerated received due process in legal matters and the termination of their parental rights. Women incarcerated are being able to attend or participate in the termination of their parental rights, if not incarcerated for neglecting, abuse, or serious harm to their children. The board meet about twice a year during the month of April and November or as needed.

I am a member of the Martin Luther King Committee. The committee members organize, plan and fundraise for the once a year Martin Luther King event that take place in January. The event involves community involvement and participation such as University of Oregon, Northwest Christian College, keynote speaker from local community, and awarding students from the local school district. We start meeting in the month of October and increase the meeting to every two weeks during the month of November until event in January.

I am a member of the Sexual Assault Response Team (SART). The team consist of a group of members from local police departments, sex offender therapy, youth services, UO Health Clinic, Sacred Heart and McKenzie-Willamette Hospital, and Senior & Disable Services. The Sexual Assault Response team works on improving the response to Oregon's vulnerable population. We want to make maintain a high level of commitment to continuing and improving the response to adolescent and adult sexual assault. The group meet once a month and usually skip two months out of year.

I am the Secretary for Blacks In Government local chapter. The chapter consist of a group of minorities working for city, state, county, or federal government in Lane County. Blacks In Government (BIG) is a national response to the need for Afro-Americans in public service to organize around issues of mutual concern and use of their collective strength to confront workplace and community issues. BIG's goal are to promote equity in all aspects of American life, excellence in public service, and opportunity for all Americans.



1. A brief description of the experience or training that qualifies me for membership on the committee.

I began volunteering in human services in this county in 1990, shortly after moving to this community. From 2000-2005, I worked as the Executive Director of Womenspace, Inc., an HSC funded program. More recently, I have volunteered as the lead Public Relations volunteer for the city, county and community collaboration on Project Homeless Connect (PHC), and currently serve on the state Department of Human Services, Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault Fund Advisory Committee (DHS-DVSA) which allocates statewide monles primarily derived from our Marriage License Tax and Criminal Fines Assessments.

2. Why I want to become a member of the committee and what specific contributions I hope to make.

My long time interest and engagement in providing quality human services motivates my applying for membership. Specifically I believe I can contribute from the perspective of someone what has administered HSC funds at the programmatic level.

- 3. The community concerns that I would like to see addressed if appointed. I would obviously be able to give particular attention to the needs of survivors of domestic violence and sexual assault, and to those in our community who are without safe and stable homes, or at risk of homelessness. Also, I am a single parent—and was privileged enough to be able to temporarily leave my career in non-profit management in order to focus on parenting—and so would be particularly sensitive to the needs of parents and children in our community living in single-parent homes.
- 4. My present or past involvement in relevant community groups.
 In addition to PHC and the DHS-DVSA Fund Committee mentioned above, I worked since its initiation with the Lane County Domestic Violence Council where in the early days I facilitated the formation of the Batterer Intervention Committee. I later served as Chair of that committee and regularly participated on its Criminal Justice Committee.
 - 5. If selected, how I would contribute to Lane County's effort to reflect diverse cultures on its boards/committees, and to not discriminate against any person on the basis of gender, race, color, national origin, religion, disability, or age.

As a woman I am a member of at least one group that has historically been underrepresented in decision making capacities; though women perhaps have suffered less discrimination in human services than in most other professions. Other than gender, I would not by virtue of my background contribute to the committee's representativeness of Lane County's diversity. On the other hand, I have a PhD in Sociology and throughout my career have demonstrated a commitment to learning, educating and doing something about both subtle and overt forms of racism, ageism, able-ism, ethnocentrism, and other forms of discrimination against social groups lacking power.
