#### II. AGENDA ITEM SUMMARY

A Right of Way Grant Offer from the Bureau of Land Management needs to be accepted for Row River Road at M. P. 16.64, so that it may be included in the formal Order of Alteration to be proposed by the County Surveyor's office for the affected portion of County Road pursuant to ORS 93.80 and Lane Manual 21.400.

#### III. BACKGROUND/IMPLICATIONS OF ACTION

#### A. Board Action and Other History

The Board awarded a contract for minor realignment and construction of a new bridge on Row River Road at M. P. 16.64 on November 21, 2006 per Order 06-11-21-5. The project was completed in January of 2008, and a survey showing the road centerline and right of way monumentation was filed in the Office of the Lane County Surveyor, under County Survey No. 41468 on May 5, 2009. The additional and revised right of way needs to be accepted as County Right of Way and the attached Offer of Grant Right of Way Grant needs to be accepted and executed on behalf of Lane County prior to recordation.

#### B. Policy Issues

Through adoption of the Lane County Transportation System Plan, the Board has established that maintenance of the road system is a core priority for the use of the Road Fund and Department Resources. Acceptance of the Right of Way Grant Offer is consistent with said priority.

#### C. Board Goals

This project was consistent with the County Goals of contributing "to appropriate community development in the areas of transportation and telecommunications infrastructure, housing, growth management and land development", and protection of the public's assets by maintaining, replacing or upgrading the County's investments in systems and capital infrastructure". Also, in the Lane County Strategic Plan under Section B-3(d)(6), it is stated that

"Operation, maintenance, and preservation (OM&P) of the existing County road system will receive the highest priority".

#### D. Financial and/or Resource Considerations

No additional expense will be incurred in connection with this project once the Alteration Order has been approved. Although the verbiage in Paragraph 3 calls for the payment of rent, none is required pursuant to 43 CFR, Part 2806.14 which exempts federal, state and local governments unless the right of way is used for commercial purposes or for municipal utility purposes wherein the source of revenue is customer charges.

#### E. Analysis

The Board is being asked to authorize the County Administrator to sign and accept Right of Way Grant No. 63540 as shown on Attachment 1 so that it may be recorded in the Office of Deeds and Records of Lane County and included in the proposed Order of Alteration.

#### F. Alternatives/Options

1. Approve the Order accepting the Offer of Right of Way Grant No. 63540 and authorize the County Administrator to sign the grant on behalf of Lane County.

- A right-of-way is hereby granted pursuant to Title V of the Federal Land Policy and Management Act of October 21, 1976 (90 Stat. 2776; 43 U.S.C. 1761).
- 2. Nature of Interest:
  - a. By this instrument, the holder:

receives a right to construct, operate, maintain, and terminate a roadway and bridge on public lands described as follows:

T 22 S., R. 1 W., W.M., Lane County, Oregon: Those portions of the NEWNEW of Sec. 5 located as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

- The right-of-way or permit area granted herein is between 10 feet and 35 feet wide and approximately 240 feet long and contains 0.15 acres more or less.
- c. This instrument is perpetual unless it is relinquished, abandoned, terminated, or modified pursuant to the terms and conditions of this instrument or of any applicable Federal law or regulation.
- d. Notwithstanding early relinquishment, abandonment, or termination, the provisions of this instrument, to the extent applicable, shall continue in effect and shall be binding on the holder, its successors, or assigns, until they have fully satisfied the obligations and/or liabilities accruing herein before or on account of the expiration, or prior termination, of the grant.

#### 3. Rental:

For and in consideration of the rights granted, the holder agrees to pay the Bureau of Land Management fair market value rental as determined by the authorized officer unless specifically exempted from such payment by regulation. Provided, however, that the rental may be adjusted by the authorized officer, whenever necessary, to reflect changes in the fair market rental value as determined by the application of sound business management principles, and so far as practicable and feasible, in accordance with comparable commercial practices.

#### 4. Terms and Conditions:

- a. This grant or permit is issued subject to the holder's compliance with all applicable regulations contained in Title 43 Code of Federal Regulations part 2800.
- b. Upon grant termination by the authorized officer, all improvements shall be removed from the public lands within 90 days, or otherwise disposed of as provided in paragraph (4)(d) or as directed by the authorized officer.
- c. Each grant issued for a term of 20 years or more shall, at a minimum, be reviewed by the authorized officer at the end of the 20th year and at regular intervals thereafter not to exceed 10 years. Provided, however, that a right-of-way or permit granted herein may be reviewed at any time deemed necessary by the authorized officer.
- d. The stipulations, plans, maps, descriptions or designs set forth in Exhibits A and B, dated May 12, 2006 attached hereto, are incorporated into and made a part of this grant instrument as fully and effectively as if they were set forth herein in their entirety.
- Failure of the holder to comply with applicable law or any provision of this right-of-way grant or permit shall constitute grounds for suspension or termination thereof.
- f. The holder shall perform all operations in a good and workmanlike manner so as to ensure protection of the environment and the health and safety of the public.
- g. This grant supercedes any right-of-way obtained pursuant to the Act of July 26, 1866 (Revised Statute 2477). The right-of-way for Lane County Road No. 4086 across the lands included in this grant shall henceforth be administered according to the terms and conditions of this grant and applicable Federal laws and regulations.



#### **EXHIBIT A**

#### LEGAL DESCRIPTION

A parcel of land lying in the Northeast one-quarter of the Northeast one-quarter (NE ½ NE ½ ) of Section 5, Township 22 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, Lanc County, Oregon, and being a portion of that tract of land conveyed to UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, by that certain deed recorded August 25, 1994, on Reel 1986, Recorder's Reception Number 9462054, LANE COUNTY OREGON DEED RECORDS, included in a strip of land variable feet in width lying on the southerly side of the centerline of the realignment of Row River Road as surveyed by Lane County in 2006; the centerline and widths in feet being described as follows:

Beginning at Engineers' Centerline Station L4 263+10.84 PT, said station being 90.59 feet South and 965.73 feet West of the Northeast Corner of Section 5, Township 22 South, Range I West of the Willamette Meridian, Lane County, Oregon; run thence South 51° 08' 30" East, 185.59 feet; thence along a 347.25 foot radius curve left (the long chord of which bears South 89° 52' 03" East, 434.47 feet) a distance of 469.40 feet to Engineers' Centerline Station L4 269+65.83 PT and there ending, all in Lane County, Oregon.
