#### MOTION I.

In the Matter of Delegating Authority to the County Administrator to Execute a Software Contract with NextGen for a Maximum Period of Fifty Years

#### 11. AGENDA ITEM SUMMARY

The Board is being asked to approve a contract with NextGen for an electronic health record application for the Community Health Centers (CHC) and to delegate authority to the County Administrator to execute the agreement, Item 5 of which grants the County a license for a term of fifty (50) years from the effective date of the agreement, unless sooner terminated.

### BACKGROUND/IMPLICATIONS OF ACTION III.

### Α. Board Action and Other History

The Board approved selection of this contractor for the provision of an electronic health record via BO 11-5-24-4.

#### B. Policy Issues

None. The fifty-year verbiage in Item 5 of the proposed agreement does not inhibit the County's ability to discontinue the use of the NextGen suite of products, should they become obsolete or be replaced by other medical record software purchased by Lane County on behalf of the CHC.

#### C. **Board Goals**

### D. Financial and/or Resource Considerations

Acceptance of the fifty-year license does not affect the cost of the electronic health record suite of applications/software.

### E. Analysis

Software agreements are frequently offered for unstated periods, that extend for the "life" of the program or application. The acceptance of a fifty year license does not bind the CHC to utilize the product, beyond whatever its actual validity as an electronic health record application may be.

The attached contract will be subject to full review by IS, County Counsel, Risk Management and the Administrator's Office, including Budget and Planning, as part of its approval process.

## F. Alternative / Options

- To accept the proposed fifty-year license and delegate authority to the County Administrator to execute a software contract with NextGen.
- To not approve the acceptance of a fifty-year license and to direct H&HS to negotiate a revision to Item 5 of the proposed agreement to provide for automatic renewal of the license in twelve-month increments.

## IV. TIMING/IMPLEMENTATION

It is anticipated that the contract will be executed in late September or early October.

## V. RECOMMENDATION

H&HS supports the execution of the agreement, as is, based on the Analysis provided in Item III.E above.

## VI. FOLLOW-UP

If approved, H&HS will list this contract on the annual budget adoption order for continuance for every year beyond the initial three years.
