



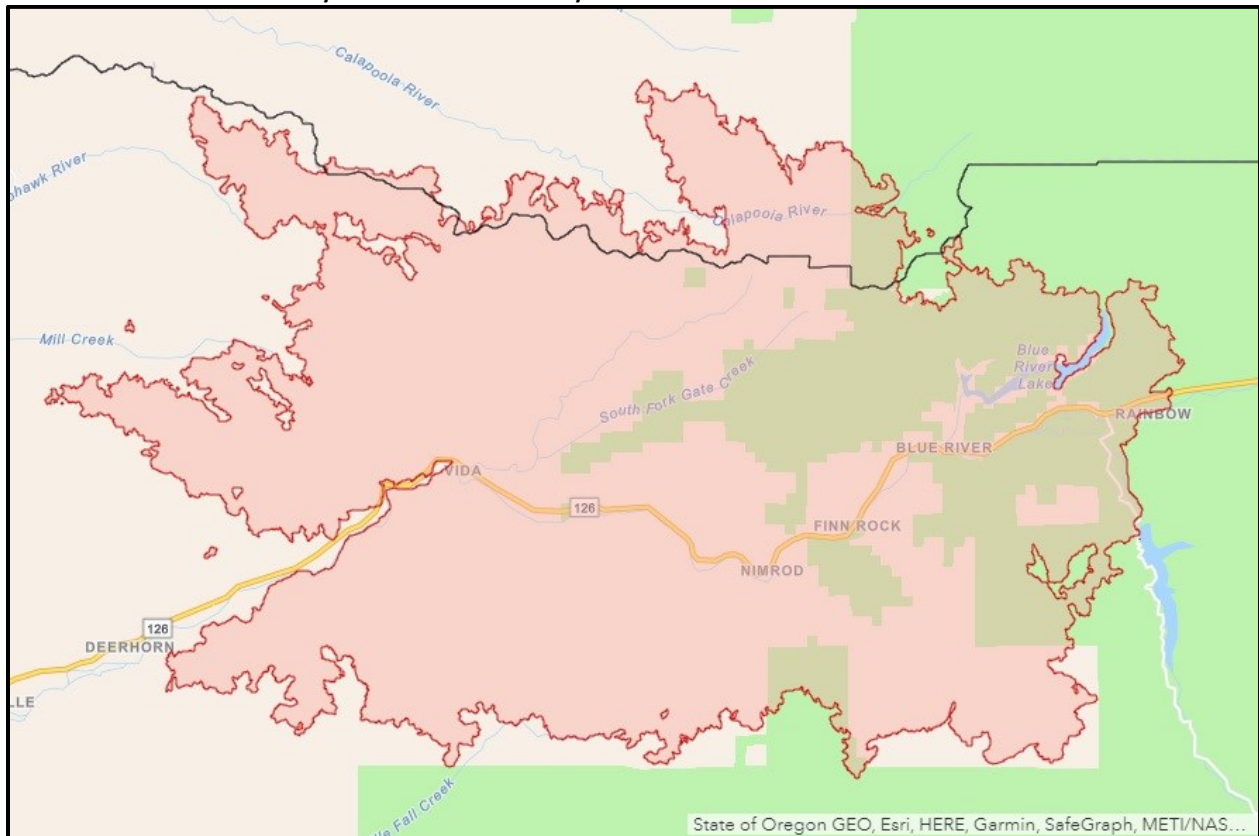
## UPDATE: Winter Weather Response Priority Change Holiday Farm Fire Burn Area

Lane County Public Works – Road Maintenance

### General Awareness

The recent fires in the Upper McKenzie River Valley elevate the risk of debris movement following rain and other typical winter weather events. With this awareness, County Road Maintenance Crews will be monitoring roads and adjacent facilities within the burn area as a top priority.

### Response Activities

The County roads and facilities within the burn area will be monitored for:

- debris runoff
- fallen rocks
- debris build-up at:
  - culvert inlets
  - ditches
  - storm water facilities
