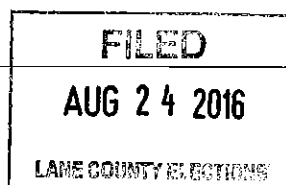

Final Ballot Title The following is the final ballot title of the measure to be submitted to the county's voters. The ballot title notice has been published and the ballot title challenge process has been completed.

Shall Lane County impose a tax of 3% on recreational marijuana products sold within the unincorporated area of Lane County?

<p>Oregon's laws establishing the legal sale of recreational marijuana products provides that a local jurisdiction may establish up to a 3% tax on the sale of marijuana products via a local ordinance which must then be approved by voters.</p> <p>The Board of County Commissioners passed Ordinance 16-04, which amends Lane Code Chapter 4 (taxation).</p> <p>The Ordinance:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *Defines certain terms related to the sale of recreational marijuana products *Imposes a 3% tax rate on marijuana products sold within unincorporated Lane County *Provides that the marijuana retailer must collect the tax *Provides that the tax revenue will be directed to county services through the annual budget process <p>This tax only applies to retailers licensed by the Oregon Liquor Control Commission to sell recreational marijuana products within unincorporated Lane County. Passage of this tax would add 3% to the existing state tax rate of 17%. Medical marijuana will remain untaxed.</p>
