Executive Summary

The District Attorney is responsible for the prosecution of all felony offenses and most misdemeanor offenses committed in Lane County. Due to a reduction of staff in 2012, we had severely compromised the effective prosecution of thousands of cases and failed to file over 1,000 viable cases per year from 7/2012-7/2015. By obtaining some grant funding to assist in paying for three prosecutors and increasing the individual caseloads of the attorneys, we remain on track to file all viable cases.
