Details: Guilty Plea in Pleasant Hill Murder Case

State v. Andrew Paul Geronimi

Lane County Circuit Court case no. 21CR38528

On Monday, August 9, 2021, around 6:30 a.m., Lane County Sheriff's deputies and Oregon State Troopers responded to a residence in the 37000 block of Hwy 58 in Pleasant Hill regarding a homicide that occurred that morning at the residence.

Deputies found Caelen Ann Bosisto, age 30, deceased at the location due to homicidal violence. The Lane County Medical examiner concluded her cause of death to be a gunshot wound to the chest. Her husband, Staton Ryan Bosisto, was transported from the scene with serious injuries caused by a gunshot wound to the head.

Deputies and troopers on scene that morning located Andrew Paul Geronimi, then age 34, in the brush nearby the home armed with a handgun. He was arrested the same date, and subsequently indicted by the Lane County Grand Jury for multiple charges related to the event, including Murder in the First Degree, Attempted Murder, and Burglary in the First Degree.

Today, Mr. Geronimi appeared with his attorneys before Lane County Circuit Court Judge Charles M. Zennache and entered guilty pleas to:

- 1. Murder in the First Degree (V/Caelen Bosisto)
- 2. Assault in the First Degree (V/Staton Bosisto)
- 3. Attempted Murder in the Second Degree (V/Staton Bosisto)
- 4. Burglary in the First Degree

The Court scheduled sentencing in this matter for <u>Friday, April 28, 2023, 1:00 p.m.</u> Mr. Geronimi faces life in prison on the charge of Murder in the First Degree.
