IN THE MATTER OF AUTHORIZING LANE COUNTY PUBLIC WORKS STAFF TO APPLY FOR CONGESTION MITIGATION AND AIR QUALITY (CMAQ) IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FUNDS, AUTHORIZING COMMITMENT OF MATCHING FUNDS, AND, IF SUCCESSFUL, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE ASSOCIATED INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENTS

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners desires to seek grant opportunities to help defray the costs of maintaining the County road system and promote safety; and

WHEREAS, the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) application process is open for FY 2016 – 2018, for projects within the Central Lane Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO); and

WHEREAS, Lane County staff is preparing applications for the following Safe Routes to Schools infrastructure projects:

- Yolanda Elementary and Briggs Middle Schools constructing bicycle and walking infrastructure on portions of Yolanda Avenue, 23rd Street, and 31st Street, in Springfield
- Centennial Elementary completing a sidewalk gap on a portion of Menlo Loop, in Springfield
- Howard Elementary and Colin Kelly Middle Schools constructing bicycle and walking infrastructure on North Park Avenue and a pedestrian crossing at Maxwell Road and North Park Avenue, in Eugene

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

- That Lane County Public Works staff be authorized to submit funding applications to apply for these projects, and that Lane County commits to providing staff in-kind match for each of the projects, if funded; AND
- 2. That if any of the grants are approved the County Administrator be authorized to execute associated Intergovernmental Agreements to proceed with the project(s) and the County to be reimbursed through the grant program.
