AND THE REGULATION OF PREMIUM CIGARS


**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County has a stated interest in promoting the public's health and in countering the negative impact of tobacco/nicotine on County residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board supports the objectives of the current Community Health Improvement Plan, which support submitting these comments;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. That the Chair of the Board be delegated authority to sign the attached letter to the U.S. Food and Drug Administration regarding nicotine levels in cigarettes and Health & Human Services be authorized to submit the letter via the online portal; and
2. That the Chair of the Board be delegated authority to sign the attached letter to the U.S. Food and Drug Administration regarding flavored tobacco/nicotine products and Health & Human Services be authorized to submit the letter via the online portal; and
3. That the Chair of the Board be delegated authority to sign the attached letter to the U.S. Food and Drug Administration regarding the regulation of premium cigars and Health & Human Services be authorized to submit the letter via the online portal.
