(SAMHSA) GRANT FUNDING VIA A
SUBGRANT THROUGH OREGON HEALTH
AUTHORITY (OHA) IN AN AMOUNT UP TO
\$3,000,000.00

WHEREAS, the County has adopted as a strategic priority the promotion of a Safe and Healthy County; and


WHEREAS, acceptance of SAMHSA grant funds would permit the County to provide and promote developmentally appropriate and culturally competent services and intervention approaches to youth and young adults with serious mental disorders; and

WHEREAS, Lane Manual 20.650(4) requires that the Board of County Commissioners approve the application for grants in excess of \$100,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

- 1) Approve acceptance of SAMHSA grant funding to support mental health services and infrastructure development for youth ages 16 to 25 via a subgrant through OHA in an amount up to \$3,000,000.00 for the period of 9/30/2018 through 9/29/ 2023; and
- 2) It is further ordered that the County Administrator is delegated authority to sign any subgrant or related contract documents, including grant extensions.
