At our Board meeting on September 27th, we will request approval of two budgets for our fiscal year beginning October 1st; the overall Agency budget and the public housing operating budget. Normally we would turn in all of the budget documents on September 13th. This year, however, we would not be able to submit accurate and complete budgets by that date.

As you may remember, HUD is requiring housing authorities to convert to project-based budgeting and accounting. In HACSA's case, we will need to prepare seven separate public housing budgets, even though the Board will approve only the combined budget (as has been the case in prior years). In addition HUD has made a considerable number of changes in the way operating subsidies are calculated. As a result, HACSA (as is the case for all Oregon housing authorities) will be faced with reduced funding.

Unfortunately, HUD has been very slow to issue the rules and regulations for these significant changes. We are still trying to get answers to several questions. Since the public housing budget is a very important piece of the Agency budget, we have been delayed there as well. Consequently, we expect to be able to submit both budgets to the Board by September 22nd. We will submit the Board orders by September 13th. Please let me know if this schedule will not work for the Board.
