II. AGENDA ITEM SUMMARY

The State of Oregon has requested to purchase a parcel of County-owned Road Fund surplus property located at the southwest quadrant of the Beltline Highway/Coburg Road Interchange in order to expand the existing eastbound off-ramp from Beltline Highway to Coburg Road and to construct an extension of the existing sound wall for the benefit of adjacent residential areas.

III. BACKGROUND/IMPLICATIONS OF ACTION

A. <u>Board Action and Other History</u>

Lane County purchased the subject property in connection with the construction of Beltline Highway in 1961. Jurisdiction over Beltline Highway (now OR 569) was later transferred to the State of Oregon, but the transfer did not include the 5.7 acre subject property located at the south side of Beltline and just westerly of Coburg Road because it was located outside the established right of way limits of the highway. A map depicting the boundaries of the subject parcel is attached and marked as Attachment 1.

B. Policy Issues

This property is not needed for use by Lane County now or in the foreseeable future. Sale to the State of Oregon will assist the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) in improving the flow of traffic with the Beltline Highway corridor.

C. Board Goals

This project addresses the County Goal of contributing to "appropriate community development" in the area of transportation and telecommunications infrastructure, housing, growth management and land development."

D. Financial and/or Resource Considerations

Sale of this Road Fund asset will avoid future expense associated with the maintenance of this property. Because is it a Road Fund asset, the proceeds of the sale if approved by the Board, will be returned to the Road Fund.

IV. Analysis

ORS 271.310 provides that whenever the public interest may be furthered, a political subdivision may convey all or any part of its interest to a governmental body or private individual or corporation. The statute specifies that consideration for the transfer may be cash or real property or both. The State's offer to purchase the property is in the amount of \$1,043,000.00, based on an ODOT staff appraisal with an effective date of March 17, 2008. The appraisal has been reviewed by Lane County staff and the conclusion of value was found to be adequately supported at the upper end of the range of value based on the cited market data.

All expenses in connection with the transaction will be paid by the State of Oregon.

V. Alternatives/Options

- Approve the Order and resolution authorizing the sale of the abovereferenced property to the State of Oregon, authorizing the execution of the attached Warranty Deed and authorizing the County Administrative Officer to sign all documents in connection with the closing of the transaction.
- 2. Deny the Order and direct staff otherwise.

VI. <u>TIMING/IMPLEMENTATION</u>

Upon execution by the Board, the Warranty Deed will be placed in escrow. Upon close of escrow, the proceeds from the sale will be deposited in the Road Fund.
