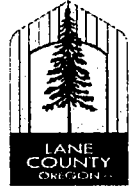

I. MOTION

ORDER _____ / In the Matter of Re-Appointing One Member to the Public Health Advisory Committee.

II. AGENDA ITEM SUMMARY

The Public Health Advisory Committee (HAC) seeks to fill one vacancy created by an August, 2007 term expiration. This nomination represents a re-appointment.

III. BACKGROUND/IMPLICATIONS OF ACTION

A. Board Action and Other History

This committee's name was changed via BO 07-12-5-2 (from the Community Health Advisory Committee to the Public Health Advisory Committee, to avoid confusion with the Community Health Council). Most recent appointments to this committee were made via BO 07-9-18-1 (three members). Last by-laws revision approved via BO 04-2-18-3.

The original vacancy announcement advertised from July 11 through August 14, 2007 produced an insufficient number of candidates to fill all vacancies. One at-large position (position # 3) was re-advertised from October 8 through November 9, 2007.

At the close of the advertising period five applications, all representing Commissioner District 3, had been received. One of the applications represented a request for re-appointment (Ruth Duemler, to position # 3). Ms. Duemler resides in Commissioner District 3 and is eligible for appointment to a sequential term under the committee by-laws.

The proposed appointment would be as follows:

- District 3 – 9 members
- District 5 – 3 members

B. Policy Issues

All five applicants met the minimum qualifications for service on this advisory committee and the Public Health Advisory Committee (HAC) appointed a nominations subcommittee to review the applications. The subcommittee recommended Ms. Duemler's re-appointment and the HAC approved that selection at their session on December 11, 2007.

As stated above, all five applications came from Commissioner District 3, so no consideration was given to committee representation by district.

C. Board Goals

Meets Board objective of encouraging citizen participation.

D. Financial and/or Resource Considerations

Recruitment for committees represents a significant, ongoing expense for H&HS.

E. Analysis

The HAC membership includes five at-large positions (one at-large position, #15, is currently encumbered by a professional, namely a physician). The HAC appointments subcommittee felt strongly that Position # 3 should not be encumbered by a health care professional. Three of the five applicants worked within the health care industry. Of the two remaining applicants, one was Ms. Duemler and the other a new applicant.

Public Health staff report that Ruth Duemler has made significant contributions to the HAC and her re-appointment has strong support. The ongoing budget uncertainties increase the importance of a strong HAC, enhanced by committed members.

F. Alternatives / Options

1. Appoint the nominated candidate.
2. Reject the nomination and re-post the vacancy.
3. Direct the Public Health Advisory Committee to re-consider appointment of one of the other four respondents to the most recent vacancy advertisement.

IV. TIMING/IMPLEMENTATION

If Board approval is received, this member would be added to the HAC with an effective date of 1/2/2008 to serve a term ending on 08/31/2011.

V. RECOMMENDATION

Both the HAC and Public Health staff approve the nomination of the committee member proposed above in number 1, under "Alternatives".

VI. FOLLOW-UP

Board approval being received, Ms. Duemler would be invited to attend the next HAC meeting, scheduled for Tuesday, January 15, 2008.

1. I have 6 years experience as Public Health Nursing Supervisor and 1 ½ years experience as Public Health Administrator for the Umatilla County Public Health Division. Additionally, I have a Graduate Certificate in Public Health from the University of Washington. These uniquely qualified me to serve on the Lane County Health Advisory Committee. In these positions I have conducted epidemiological investigations for communicable diseases, developed and implemented infant and newborn home visitation programs, conducted research on fetal/infant mortality, promoted immunizations, planned and organized coalitions for tobacco prevention, suicide prevention, and teen pregnancy prevention, and directed a family planning program. I have worked with the Oregon Health Division as well as community groups.
2. I will bring to the Committee extensive experience and knowledge of public health and social services along with the understanding of the budget constraints within county government. I also have worked with the Oregon Health Division and would be a great liaison between the community and the Health Division. I believe that when the public is given accurate information, such as disease prevention strategies, most people will change their behavior to improve their health and the health of their family. I am willing to bring those messages to the community and to bring the community's concerns to county and state government.
3. Communicable disease prevention, especially MRSA, HIV and Hepatitis, influenza and food-borne illnesses are all issues that are important in the community. Environmental public health, such as the Union Pacific Railyard, in Northwest Eugene is a concern. The high fetal/infant mortality rate in Lane County is unacceptable. All of these issues can be tackled by the Committee
4. Since moving to Lane County two years ago, I have not been involved in any relevant community groups here. However, I have extensive experience working with the Umatilla County Coalition Against Tobacco, Umatilla County Suicide Prevention Coalition, and Reduce Adolescent Pregnancy Project (RAPP) in Umatilla County.
5. My entire work history has been working with the poor, homeless, mentally ill or substance abusing populations. I am very familiar with the unique challenges marginalized populations face in accessing medical care and social services. By bringing this understanding to the Advisory Committee I hope to be able to remove barriers to access to care. It is important to me that the general population gains an understanding that public health is not just for people who do not have medical insurance; it is for and about everybody. I believe every individual, regardless of gender, race, color, national origin, religion, disability, age, sexual orientation or socioeconomic status, has inherent worth and should be treated with dignity.
