_____/ In the Matter of Appointing One Member to ORDER Fill a Vacancy on the Mental Health Advisory/Local Alcohol and Drug Planning Committee.

II. AGENDA ITEM SUMMARY

The Mental Health Advisory/Local Alcohol and Drug Planning Committee (MHAC/LADPC) LM3.524 seeks to fill one vacancy created the November 2007 resignation of a member whose term expires on August 31, 2010.

III. BACKGROUND/IMPLICATIONS OF ACTION

A. Board Action and Other History

Vacancy notices were advertised from November 2007 through April 2008.

No applications were received in response to the first three vacancy periods (November 2007 through March 2008). At the close of the most recent advertising period, March 13, 2008 through April 10, 2008, six applications were received.

The MHAC/LADPC convened a subcommittee and conducted interviews of the six applicants. The MHAC/LADPC herewith nominated a candidate with an extensive background in alcohol and drug counseling and rehabilitation and was chosen for appointment.

1. Give a brief description of the experience or training that qualifies you for membership on this advisory committee (If you wish, you may attach a resume or other pertinent material.)

I have worked as a psychiatrist, administrator, and medical school facultry member in many settings since 1970. These include a university student health center, private practice, a military hospital, Veterans Administration Hospitals and headquarters, and community hospital settings, most recently at PeaceHea.lth in Eugene. I am Board Certified and until November 2006 was the Medical Director for Behavioral Health at PeaceHealth Oregon Region.

2. Why do you want to become a member of this committee, and what specific contributions do you hope to make?

Throughout my career in mental health, I have worked to improve access and quality of services for people needing mental health care. My goal in serving on this advisory committee is to bring my 40 years of training and experience to the deliberations and recommendations of the committee. Because I have worked with the challenges facing patients, outpatient programs, and hospitals directly and as a consultant I hope to be an asset to the committee.

3. List the community concerns related to this committee that you would like to see addressed if you are appointed.

Lane County struggles with all of the issues facing communities around the country. Access to mental health services, provision of care in the most suitable and least restrictive way, (the right care in the right setting) planning ways to deal with the increasing pressure for services despite declining resources will be important issues for years to come. Finding economically viable long term approaches to these issues have been and will continue to be high priority challenges for all concerned..patients, families, local government, law enforcement and the provider community. Services for children, chemical dependency and the elderly as well as basic outpatient care are beng severely tested. Wider dialogue and collaboration may help soften the challenges ahead.

4. Briefly describe your present or past involvement in relevant community groups. (Having no previous involvement will not disqualify you for appointment.)

In the 1970's I was a member and then the president of the Homestead Neighborhood Association in Portland at the time a Veterans Administration replacement hospital was being proposed.
