Bonds Funding Lane County Multiuse Stadium at Fairgrounds

Shall Eugene contribute funds towards the Lane County multiuse stadium at the fairgrounds using \$15 million of general obligation bonds? If the bonds are approved, they will be payable from taxes on property or property ownership that are not subject to the limits of sections 11 and 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.			
Summary 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect.			
If approved, proceeds from the sale of the bonds will be used for capital costs related to construction of the Lane County multiuse stadium at the Lane County Fairgrounds. If approved, proceeds from bonds' sale will fund a portion of the stadium's total capital costs, estimated at \$90 million. Based on Lane County's conceptual stadium design, a multiuse stadium at the Lane County Fairgrounds will function as the Eugene Emeralds' home baseball stadium and could be programmed for music events, sporting events, and other community events. If constructed Lane County will own the multiuse stadium and lease it to the Emeralds. If approved but construction on the multiuse stadium does not commence at the fairgrounds, the bonds will not be sold, no bond proceeds will be generated, and no money will be provided to Lane County. If approved, the estimated rate is \$0.08 per \$1000 of assessed value per year for 20 years, cost to average Eugene homeowner would be about \$22 per year. Bonds would be limited to principal amount of \$15 million.
