WHEREAS, Lane County and City of Eugene have been awarded the FY 2012 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) in the amount of \$99,963 to fund a portion of the cost of analytical services for the Public Safety Coordinating Council, and law enforcement equipment in both the Sheriff's Office and Eugene Police Department.

WHEREAS, Lane County and the City of Eugene are disparate and therefore split the total grant funds 50/50, thereby providing each agency \$49,981.50.

WHEREAS, the Department of Justice JAG program awarded the grant to Lane County and the City of Eugene on July 25, 2012.

WHEREAS, Lane Manual 21.145(b) requires Board of Commissioners approval for the executions of agreements exceeding three years in length.

WHEREAS, the signed grant award documents are due to the Office of Justice Programs prior to October 1, 2012.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the Board of County Commissioners delegates authority to the County Administrator to accept the grant award and execute all related grant documents.
