## BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LANE COUNTY, OREGON

ORDER 12-10-17-04 IN THE MATTER OF DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH EXECUTIVE INFORMATION SERVICES, INC. TO PURCHASE A PUBLIC SAFETY INFORMATION SYSTEM INCLUDING JAIL AND RECORD MANAGEMENT AND COMPUTER-AIDED DISPATCH

**Whereas,** Sheriff's Office operations require a stable, reliable public safety information system to replace AIRS, a 40-year-old software package that can no longer be maintained or updated; and

**Whereas**, the Board of Commissioners approved use of an expedited procurement process to review and select a vendor-supplied solution; and

Whereas, the procurement process included invitations to all vendors responding to a similar RFP process in Douglas County; and

Whereas, vendor products were evaluated against key criteria developed by the Sheriff's Office; and

**Whereas**, two vendors were found to meet these key criteria and invited to provide on-site demonstrations; and

Whereas, additional evaluation and analysis resulted in a recommendation to purchase the product offered by Executive Information Systems, Inc. (EIS); and

Whereas, the Sheriff's Office supports this recommendation and wishes to enter into an agreement with EIS.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that a contract for a public safety information system is awarded to Executive Information Systems, Inc. and that the County Administrator is delegated authority to execute a contract substantially similar to the draft contract attached.
