WHEREAS, The Oregon Enterprise Zone program is a State program established by the legislature in 1985 for the primary purposes of job creation, encouraging new investment, diversification, and competitiveness

WHEREAS, the West Eugene Enterprise Zone (WEEZ) was designated by the State of Oregon for a ten-year period and expires in 2015

WHEREAS, the West Eugene Enterprise Zone is jointly sponsored by the City of Eugene and Lane County

WHEREAS, a minor zone boundary amendment to the West Eugene Enterprise Zone will allow two major brewery investments by Oakshire Brewing and Hop Valley Brewing Company to locate in Eugene's Whiteaker neighborhood which is just north of the existing boundary


WHEREAS, the aforementioned business investments have the potential to create significant new jobs and help advance the Regional Prosperity Economic Development Plan goals regarding job creation and reduced unemployment

WHEREAS, the Community & Economic Development Division supports the recruitment, retention and expansion of businesses within the food and beverage industry cluster

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Lane County hereby approves the minor zone boundary amendment to the West Eugene Enterprise Zone; thereby further supporting the economic regional identity goals expressed in the Economic Development Plan.
