ORDER NO: 12-11-28-01

IN THE MATTER OF ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE WILLAKENZIE FIRE DISTRICT TO PROVIDE FIRE PROTECTION SERVICE TO THE ANNEXATION TERRITORY, CONSISTING OF ASSESSOR'S MAP 18-03-01 TAXLOTS 2700, 2800, 2900, 3000, 3100, 3201, AND 3500 ALONG WITH MAP 18-02-06 TAXLOT 1500. (FILE NO. F-WK-2012-ANX-2)

WHEREAS, a petition initiating the annexation of territory to the Willakenzie Fire District was filed with Lane County on April 30, 2012 (the "Petition for Annexation"), in accordance with ORS 198.857(3); and

WHEREAS, the territory proposed for annexation is described in Exhibit A and depicted on the map shown on Exhibit B, both of which are attached and incorporated by this reference; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Willakenzie Fire District adopted a resolution approving the proposed annexation on February 2, 2012 (Resolution No. 10-10-11); and

WHEREAS, legal notice was provided on November 7, 2012 for a November 28, 2012 public hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners conducted a public hearing on November 28, 2012, to receive and consider both oral and written evidence.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

- 1. That the findings set forth in Exhibit C are hereby adopted and incorporated by this reference.
- 2. That based on the findings and evidence submitted, and the applicable law, the Petition for Annexation is hereby approved.
- 5. That the territory described on Exhibit A and depicted on Exhibit B is hereby annexed to the Willakenzie Fire District and that this annexation is effective as of November 28, 2012, in accordance with ORS 198.747(2).

Subject to the rights of the public in the existing county road along the west line of the tract above described.

A tract of land in Section 1, Township 18 South, Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a point in the center of the meandered channel of the Middle Fork of the Willamette River South 50° 40' West 11.97 chains from a point 17.68 chains South of the ¼ Section corner of the East line of Section 1 of Township 18 South Range 3 West of Willamette Meridian and running thence North 75° 38' West 732 feet; thence North 250 feet; thence South 75° 38' East 732 feet; thence South 250 feet to the Point of Beginning in Lane County, Oregon.

All that parcel of land in Section 1, Township 18 South, Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the East line of Lot 2 and the North meander line of the Willamette River in Section 1, Township 18 South, Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian, said intersection being South 0° 04' West 1933.68 feet and West 2869.01 feet from the Southeast corner of the Isaac Briggs Donation Land Claim No. 83, and running thence along the old Government meander line North 35° West 299.64 feet to a point; thence North 15° West 168.98 feet to a point; thence East 216.08 feet to the East line of said Lot 2; thence South 0° 04' West 408.67 feet to the place of beginning in Lane County, Oregon.

Subject to the rights of the public in the existing county road along the east line of the tract above described.

A tract of land in Section 1, Township 18 South, Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian, more particularly described as follows:

All that portion of the following described real property lying north of the existing channel of the Middle Fork of the Willamette River, subject to easements, reservations, and restrictions of record.

Beginning at a point in the center of the meandered channel of the Middle Fork of the Willamette River which point is South 50° West 11.97 chains from a point on the East line of Section 1, of Township 18 South, Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian, 17.68 chains South of the ¼ Section corner on the East line of said Section 1; and run thence along the center of the meandered channel North 75° 38' West 732 feet; thence North 51° West 241 feet; thence North 18° 30' West 495 feet; thence North 87° West 145 feet; thence North 63° 40' West 604 feet; thence South 60° 40' West 424.5 feet; thence South 5° 15' West 310.2 feet; thence South 13° 40' West 308.2 feet; thence East 183.5 feet; thence South 81° 30' East 670 feet; thence South 57° 07' East 782.8 feet; thence South 50° East 200 feet; thence North 80° 06' East 564.3 feet; thence North 300 feet to the Point of Beginning, in Lane County, Oregon.

A strip of land 63 feet in width extending along and parallel to the following described meander line from Point A to Point B and bounded on the Easterly and Southerly sides by said meander line.


Beginning at the ¾" iron pipe marking the Northeast corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 1 in Township 18 South Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian, said pipe bearing South 87° 43' 00" East 1358.16 feet from the West one-quarter corner of said Section 1; and run thence South 87° 43' 00" East 929.57 feet along the North line of Lot 3 of said Section 1 to a 5/8" pin; thence South 09° 51' 00" East 907.60 feet to a point; thence South 89° 51' 00" East 63.41 feet to a point on the meander line of the right bank of the Willamette River hereinafter referred to as Point A; thence following said meander line South 01° 43' 52" West 277.81 feet to a point; thence South 26° 43' 52" West 394.05 feet to a point; thence South 36° 43' 52" West 737.77 feet to a point; thence South 78° 43' 52" West 554.78 feet to a point on the West line of said Lot 3 hereinafter referred to as Point B; all in said Section 1, Lane County, Oregon.

That land lying East of the West line of Lot 3 of Section 1, Township 18 South, Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian and inside the meander line of the Willamette River in Section 1, Township 18 South, Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian, in Lane County, Oregon.

Except that portion conveyed from the State of Oregon, acting by and through the Division of State Lands, to W. J. Reeves and Molly K. Reeves, husband and wife, by Deed recorded January 16, 1978, Reception No. 78-03246, Lane County Oregon Records.

Beginning at a point in the middle of the Thompson Slough 1.5 chains West of the Southeast corner of the North half of the Northwest quarter of Section 12, Township 18 South, Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian; and running thence along the middle of the slough N 6° West 2.7 chains; thence North 35° West 7.10 chains; thence North 20° East 9.00 chains; thence South 80° West 9.70 chains; thence North 50° West 8.00 chains to the North line of said Section 12; thence West 4.54 chains to the meander corner on the left bank of the Willamette River, between Sections 1 and 12 of said Township and Range; thence along the meander line North 70 1/2° East 16.20 chains; thence North 27° East 623.72 feet to the True Point of Beginning of the following described tract:

From said beginning point run North 27° East 102.28 feet; thence North 15° East 54.12 feet to the South boundary of land conveyed to Sigvald B. Moe and Recorded in Book 293, Page 549, Lane County Oregon Records; thence East 141.9 feet; thence South 81° 30' East 670.0 feet; thence South 57° 07' East 364.63 feet; thence South 84° 00' West 348.75 feet; thence North 57° 07' West 160.0 feet; thence North 81° 30' West 697.61 feet to the True Point of Beginning, in Lane County, Oregon.



FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSION OF LAW

- 1. The annexation of territory to the Willakenzie Fire District was initiated on April 30, 2012 by a petition by the property owner of the proposed territory to be annexed, as authorized by ORS 198.857(3).
- 2. The application for annexation, map and legal description indicate that the territory proposed for annexation is currently not within the existing fire district boundary.
- 3. Legal notice was made on November 7, 2012 for the public hearing on November 28, 2012.
- 4. The public hearing required by ORS 198.800 was held on November 28, 2012.
- 5. The decision criteria analysis considered by the Board of County Commissioners follows.
- (A) The land is not within a district formed under the same principal Act;

<u>Finding 6(A)</u>: The proposal meets this criterion. The property proposed for annexation to Willakenzie Fire District is not located within any other Fire District boundaries.

(B) The annexation area can reasonably be served or continued to be served by the facilities or services provided by the district;

<u>Finding 6(B)</u>: The proposal meets this criterion. The Willakenzie Fire District verified in Resolution No. 02022012 that the properties can be served by the fire district.

(C) No land included in the annexation area will be removed if the land is benefited; and

<u>Staff Finding 6(C)</u>: The proposal meets this criterion. As proposed, no land in the annexation area will be removed if the land is benefited.

(D) The boundary change is consistent with the Lane County Rural Comprehensive Plan, other applicable refinement plans, and other adopted land use regulations or agreements.

<u>Staff Finding 6(D)</u>: The proposal meets this criterion. The territory is located within the Eugene-Springfield Metropolitan Plan Area General Plan:

G. Public Facilities and Services Element: Goals

- 1. Provide and maintain public facilities and services in an efficient and environmentally responsible manner.
- 2. Provide public facilities and services in a manner that encourages orderly and sequential growth.

The subject properties are owned by the public utility Springfield Utility Board. One of the taxlots included in this annexation houses their water treatment facility. It is important for these properties to be served by the Willakenzie Fire District to protect such an important public facility.

No other refinement plans, adopted land use regulations or agreements have been identified that conflict with this proposal.
