MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

LRIG and SW7 Cost-Sharing of Motorola Solutions, Inc., Multi-Year Contract

This adjunct Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is hereby made and entered into by and between the Counties of Benton, Linn, and Lane; the Cities of Eugene and Springfield; and the Eugene Water & Electric Board (collectively, the Parties), for purposes of establishing mutual cooperation in complying with a multi-year contract with Motorola Solutions, Inc. This MOU is adjunct to the Intergovernmental Agreements of the Lane Radio Interoperability Group (LRIG) and 7-County Regional Interoperable Radio System (SW7).

1. Purpose

The purpose of this MOU is to establish a cost-sharing framework for the signatory agencies for a contract entered into on their behalf by Lane County with Motorola Solutions, Inc.

2. Context / Background

The signatory agencies of this MOU are parties to either one or both the LRIG and SW7 Intergovernmental Agreements. The Parties share a regional radio system that their law enforcement, public works and utilities rely on for day-to-day Interoperable communications. Sharing in the cost of a regionally shared system is more cost effective than investing in individually owned agency radio networks. As such, the Parties agree to pay their proportional share of the cost of the system, which includes the Motorola Solutions, Inc. contract, in accordance with the rate models adopted by LRIG and SW7 for that purpose.

3. Term

This MOU takes effect on May 27, 2014 coincident with the timing of Lane County entering into a contract with Motorola Solutions, Inc. and remains in effect for the duration of the contract. Subject to the applicable terms of the LRIG and SW7 IGAs, any Party may withdraw from this MOU upon exercising its right to terminate membership under the LRIG and/or SW7 IGA, whichever applies; however, the MOU shall continue in full force and effect for the remaining Parties during the term.

4. Counterparts

This Agreement may be executed in several counterparts (facsimile or otherwise) all of which, taken together shall constitute one agreement binding on all Parties, notwithstanding that all Parties are not signatories to the same counterpart. Each copy of this Agreement so executed shall constitute an original.

Linda,

As we discussed this afternoon, Linn County Sheriff's Office is ok with the current proposed MOU language and I have reviewed it for Linn County and I think I am ok with it as well. I would like to take a quick look at the underlying SW7 IGA as well (which you indicated you sent Don an executed copy that he would forward to me) for context and background before by final sign off.

Also, as we discussed, I think that the MOU will need to be taken to the Linn County Board of Commissioners for approval under our local contract rules. Linn County's local rules require that all agreements between governmental entities be approved by the Board. The earliest this will happen is next Tuesday or Wednesday, so hopefully this email will be sufficient for you to take to Lane County's Board on Tuesday the 20th as an indication that the Linn County Sheriff's Office is willing to participate and pay its proportional share on the Motorola contract.

Also as we discussed, it might be helpful for agencies such as Linn that can't sign and provide you the MOU's signature page before the 20th to add counterpart language to the MOU. I've attached general counterpart language I've used for contracts in the past, which you may want to run past your legal counsel. I'm copying Lane County Counsel on this so he is aware we've had contact.
