SUBJECT: Notifying Outside Agency of Hazards and Repair Needs		Related Laws:

POLICY: The Patrol Section is charged with the responsibility of the protection of life and property, the prevention of crime, and the promotion of public peace and dignity.

RULE: None

PROCEDURE:

I. Hazards

A. Employees shall be alert for:

1. Uncontrolled or illegal fires.
2. Road hazards.
3. Missing or damaged traffic signs.
4. Inoperative traffic signals.
5. Electrical failures.
6. Any other situation or condition which may prove a hazard or danger to the public.

II. Reporting

- A. Any of the above conditions or malfunctions shall be reported to Communications, as soon as possible, and shall include such details and/or directions necessary for timely response by the appropriate agency.
- B. Suggested additions or changes of traffic control signs or devices may be submitted to the field supervisor on the Sign Request Form.
