SUBJECT: Refuse Hauling Regulations		Related Laws: ORS 818.300, Lane Code 9.035

POLICY: The Traffic Safety Team has a primary mission of attempting to reduce injury and fatal traffic collisions on Lane County rural roadways through enforcement of traffic laws.

RULE: None

PROCEDURE:

I. Provisions of Lane Code 9.035

- A. No person shall transport or carry refuse in or on a motor vehicle or trailer, upon a public road in the County, unless such refuse is:
 - 1. Completely covered on all sides and on the top and bottom thereof and such cover is either a part of or securely fastened to the body of such motor vehicle or trailer, or
 - 2. Securely tied to the body of such motor vehicle or trailer so no piece, article, item, or part of such refuse is not fastened to the body of the motor vehicle or trailer.
 - 3. Contained in the body of the transport vehicle in such a way as not to cause any part of the hauled refuse to be deposited upon any roadway or driveway in the County.

II. Enforcement

- A. Warnings may be issued at the discretion of the deputy.
- B. Care will be taken not to confuse refuse handling regulations with Oregon Motor Vehicle Code 818.300 (sifting or leaking load). Those violations are cited on the Uniform Traffic Citation.
