SUBJECT: School Bus Stop Law		Related Laws: ORS 811.155, 811.157 and 811.159

POLICY: The Lane County Sheriff's Office attempts to reduce injury and fatal traffic collisions on Lane County rural roadways through enforcement of traffic laws.

RULE: None

PROCEDURE:

- I. <u>Notification of Violation</u>
 - A. School bus drivers may report violations of ORS 811.155 to local law enforcement officials having jurisdiction over the area where the violation is alleged to have occurred.
 - B. The report shall be made within 72 hours of the alleged violation and shall contain:
 - 1. Date and time of the alleged violation.
 - 2. Name of street the bus was traveling on at the time of the alleged violation and either the approximate address or name of nearest cross street.
 - 3. Direction the bus was traveling and the direction the vehicle alleged to have committed the violation was traveling.
 - 4. Weather conditions, including visibility, at the time of the alleged violations.
 - 5. Number and state of issuance of the registration plate.
 - 6. Whether the vehicle is a sedan, station wagon, van, truck, bus, motorcycle, or other type of vehicle.

- 7. Any other identifying information including, but not limited to, color of the vehicle that the reporting driver has about the vehicle.
- C. Note sample notification letter used by Creswell School District attached.
- II. Law Enforcement Response
 - A. ORS 811.159 requires law enforcement agencies, upon receipt of a report containing the information required by ORS 811.157, to:
 - 1. Determine the name and address of the registered owner of the vehicle.
 - 2. Send the registered owner a letter informing the owner that the vehicle was observed violating ORS 811.155 (see attached sample).

III. <u>Responsibility For Implementation</u>

- A. When written reports are received by the Police Records Section, personnel will carry out the law enforcement response identified in Section II of this procedure.
- B. The written report and a copy of the letter sent to the registered owner will be filed in the Records Section.
